St. James' Cup Charity Golf Tournament 2018 Tournament Information

<i>Date</i>	Tuesday, 21 August 2018
<i>Venue</i>	The Clearwater Bay Golf & Country Club
<i>Format</i>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Individual event and team event, two players per team. The players' handicap for this tournament will be calculated using the New Peoria method. Prizes will be awarded for best individual gross scores, best team aggregate gross scores and best team aggregate new Peoria scores. Winner of the St. James' Cup will be the team with the lowest aggregate gross score. All players are requested to keep up with the pace of play as recommended by The Clearwater Bay Golf & Country Club.
<i>Handicap</i>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> All players are required to have Handicap Cards. Players aged 10 & under, who do not possess an official handicap, may submit a Certificate of Competence, signed by a Club professional or a member of a recognized Professional Golf Association.
<i>Entry Fee</i>	<p>Adults & Juniors HK\$3,000/player*</p> <p><i>*Entry fee includes green fee, golf cart rental (for players 18 yrs and older only), free driving range balls for practice at the range, flags for longest drive, closest to the pin, pre-tournament lunch, post-tournament dinner and prizes.</i></p> <p><i>For any consumption of snacks & drinks at Pro-shop & 2 halfway houses during golf tournament, the payment can be settled by individual player's own expense.</i></p> <p><i>Driving range is currently under renovation, a 10-yard warm up area is available for players.</i></p>
<i>Sponsorship</i>	<p>All players are encouraged to donate over and above the Entry Fee from sponsors. Sponsorship Form is available for download from http://sjs.org.hk/en/news/event-update.php.</p>
<i>Dress Code</i>	<p>While on Club premises, participants and guests must maintain a reasonably conservative standard of dress and dress in proper golf attire while on the course. Participants and guests should dress in a manner that is inoffensive to others.</p>

NO DENIM JEANS

DENIM JEANS are definitely **NOT** permitted regardless of label, style or color.

DRESS CODE FOR MEN

T-shirts (collarless shirts or vests), sleeveless shirts and tracksuits are **NOT** permitted. **Gentlemen must wear collared shirts with sleeves, mock-neck shirts with sleeves and the shirts must be tucked into trousers at all times.** Athletic & exercise shorts, Bermuda shorts, leotards and shorts more than 4" above knees are NOT permitted. New-style men's mid-calf length shorts/trousers are NOT permitted. New-style men's combat shorts with side pockets are NOT permitted. Gentlemen may wear tailored trousers and shorts. The acceptable length for golf shorts are just above the knees.

DRESS CODE FOR LADIES

Ladies may wear sleeveless blouses provided that they are conservative and tasteful and of a type commonly considered standard golf attire. Tracksuits and vests are NOT permitted. Long and short pants as well as skirts/capris are allowed. Shorts/skirts more than 4" above knees, athletic and exercise shorts and leotards are NOT permitted.

FOOTWEAR

Suitable footwear must be worn in the Golf Clubhouse at all times. **Sandals and flipflops are NOT permitted for MEN and flip-flops are NOT allowed for LADIES.** Proper golf shoes with soft spikes or trainers are permitted at the course. Footwear or clothing may NOT be changed in any room other than the changing rooms.

If improperly dressed, guests may be asked to change into proper attire or may be asked to leave the Club premises.

Event polo shirt will be provided to all players and are available at the registration counter.

<p><i>Prizes</i></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. St. James' Cup (Overall Champion) - lowest aggregate team gross score 2. Top 2 teams (following St. James' Cup) – lowest aggregate team gross score 3. Top 3 teams – lowest aggregate team New Peoria score 4. Top 3 individual gross scores 5. Longest Drive for the Men's and Ladies' division – Hole 2 6. Closest to the pin – Hole 4 7. Hole-in-one – Hole 4 <p><i>Players/ Teams may only win one prize with the gross prize taking precedence.</i></p> <p><i>Those participating in the team competition are not eligible for the individual prizes.</i></p> <p>Bonus Game Challenge (Hole 14) - Players can choose to participate in a bonus challenge game for \$100. There will be a circle around the hole which is the radius of one flagstick. The objective is to hit within the circle. From the total pool of money from participants, 50% of the money will go to St. James' Settlement, and the other 50% to be split between the winners of the game.</p> <p>ie. If we raised \$1,000 from the game, and 2 participants hit within the circle, \$500 goes to St. James' and the other \$500 will be split amongst the 2 winners. If no one hits within the circle, 100% of the money goes to St. James.</p>
<p><i>Registration</i></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Registration counter will be opened at 11:00am. 2. All players are requested to provide photo identification, e.g. HKID/Passport. 3. Players should check in at the registration counter at least 30 minutes before their tee off time. 4. Buffet lunch will be provided at Horizons from 11:00am onwards.
<p><i>Tees</i></p>	<p>Men - White Tee Ladies - Red Tee</p>
<p><i>Golf Carts and Caddies</i></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Golf carts are available to players who are 18 years and older. Any person who needs to drive golf cart must hold a valid driving license. 2. Junior golfers must not use a golf cart at any times. Caddies should not be used.
<p><i>Drop Zone</i></p>	<p>All drop zones are in play.</p>

<i>Tee-off Times</i>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Tee-off time starts at 1:15pm shot gun 2. Rundown and tournament information are available on St. James' Settlement website http://www.sjs.org.hk/en/news/event-update.php on Saturday, 18 August 2018.
<i>Closing Ceremony</i>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Players are invited to attend the post-tournament dinner buffet and prize presentation ceremony at Horizons of Golf Club where the winners' prizes and raffle tickets prizes will be presented. 2. The dinner buffet will start at 6:30pm, will be followed by prize presentation.
<i>Media shooting</i>	There is an onsite shooting arrangement by Now TV, our Cup Sponsor.
<i>Photography Consent</i>	<p>Photography crew is arranged to take photos of players during registration, tee-off ceremony, the tournament and evening ceremony. The tournament will automatically be cancelled under any circumstances which may lead to the closure of The Clearwater Bay Golf & Country Club. 2. In the event of inclement weather conditions, i.e. the typhoon signal number 8 or above, or Black rainstorm signal is hoisted two hours prior to the program (i.e. the cutoff time is 9:00am on Tuesday, 21 August 2018), the tournament will be cancelled. 3.
